



Referring a Client to Rosalie Hall, Humewood House or Massey Centre

(Clients seeking residential services must be under 21 and pregnant or post-natal with a new born.)

STEP 1

Client needs to call the Young Parent Centre and speak to an intake worker:

A client will be seen for intake meeting as soon as possible. Often 2 meetings are held prior to admission to residence. All 3 agencies require a medical admission package to be completed by a doctor or obstetrician before approval to admit to residence.

STEP 2

Face to Face Meeting

During a face to face meeting, intake and assessment is completed. This process may take more than one meeting.

STEP 3

Provide Tour of residence.

STEP 4

Provide Residential Handbook.

Provide Medical Forms

STEP 5

Client returns completed medical forms.

STEP 6

Admission

Note: admission depends on availability of beds in the residential program.

NOTE: Consent Forms must be signed if CAS/CCAS involved and if on Probation or facing charges – consent to speak to lawyer or Probation Officer. Consent to speak to other shelter or residential program if appropriate.
